

Privacy Policy Requirements (Rhode Island) (Goes into Effect Jan 1, 2026):

What Needs to Be In The Privacy Policy?

- ☐ **1. For entities conducting business in Rhode Island, the following elements are required to be included in a privacy policy:**
 - ☐ All categories of personal data that the Controller collects through its website or online services (6-48.1-3);
 - ☐ All third parties to whom the Controller has sold or may sell customers' personally identifiable information (6-48.1-3)
 - ☐ An active e-mail address or another online mechanism that customers may use to contact the Controller (6-48.1-3).

- ☐ **2. Additionally, if the Controller sells personal data to third parties or processes personal data for targeted advertising: (6-48.1-3):**
 - ☐ The Controller must clearly and conspicuously disclose such processing.

When Does The Privacy Policy Need To Be Provided? (Section 6-48.1-3)

- ☐ When any commercial website or internet service provider collects, stores, and sells customers' personally identifiable information

Where Does The Privacy Policy Need To Be Provided? (6-48.1-3)

- ☐ In the Controller's customer agreement or incorporated addendum or in another conspicuous location on its website or online service platform where similar notices are customarily posted.
